This 4-hour virtual presentation is designed to help agencies develop real-time social media listening capabilities, which have become increasingly important after an unprecedented year. Whether deployed as part of a full-time operations center or situation room, or "surged" to meet the demands of a critical incident or major case, students will learn how to utilize tools for situational awareness, tactical intelligence, and emergency management. The instructor will also cover best practices for privacy, civil rights, civil liberties, and First Amendment events.

Topics that will be covered include:

- •Foundation in real-time online/open source/social media research
- •Review of the intelligence role in a unified command
- •Overview of the current threat environment
- •How to manage multiple streams of incoming information
- •Achieving collaboration across boundaries
- •Understanding disinformation and public trust
- •Balancing situational awareness and privacy/data protection
- •How to report or brief raw information in complex scenarios
- •How to migrate from intelligence to investigative/evidence
- •Understanding challenges and limitations
- •Discussion of free vs. premium tools
